In May 2021, it was announced that the remains of 215 children had been found on the site of a residential school near the city of Kamloops in British Columbia. Some of the remains are believed to be of children as young as three. A lack of proper documentation means the true number of those who died is likely much higher, and unmarked burial sites similar to the one at Kamloops continue to be found.

On Thursday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, CRHS will be remembering those who attended Residential schools by participating in Orange Shirt Day. On this day, all staff and students are encouraged to wear orange to acknowledge the impact of these schools on Canada's indigenous communities.
