Dear Parents/Guardians,

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Centennial Regional High School is unable to conduct the T.a.G Math and Science admission exam this year. Students from different schools are prohibited from entering the building. As a result, the selection criteria for admission into the T.a.G Math and Science program for the 2022-2023 school year will be primarily based on previous years' academic results.

In an effort to identify the best candidates for the T.a.G Math and Science program, the selection committee will review academic results (individual results and class average) from Grade 4, Grade 5 and Term 1 of Grade 6. In addition, the selection committee will communicate with elementary schools to obtain qualitative feedback on applicants.

Applications can be filled out electronically on Centennial's website starting October 12 through to October 29 at 4:00 PM. Only students NOT part of Riverside School Board must submit their report cards. Any incomplete applications will not be considered.

The selection process this year may be longer than in previous years. The current circumstances may cause unforeseen delays. The selection committee asks for your patience throughout the process. Information will be communicated as necessary.
