SUBJECT: Ethics & Religious Culture: 568 500

LEVEL: 5

Students will develop awareness to our diverse community and reflect upon as well as take actions that foster a positive community life. Students will also be encouraged to discover a frame of reference as well as engage in critical reflection on ethical questions and to understand the phenomenon of religion by practicing, in a spirit of openness, dialogue that is oriented toward contributing to an environment of acceptance.

Introduction – Discovering our references that lead to varied worldviews

Looking at the possibility of achieving Universal Justice

Become aware, depending on the society, and religious beliefs, that there are various ways of looking at justice, at the principles/forms associated with it and the questions it raises.

Religious References in Art and Culture

Appreciate that religious works of art contain references to religious writings, key figures and objects, and that these references can sometimes be found in secular art and pop culture.

Who Am I?

Existential Questions - Become aware that human beings have always asked themselves fundamental questions that various religious traditions and currents of thought have offered responses to.

Establishing a worldview through references of Sigmund Freud, C.S. Lewis and Albert Einstein
The Future of Humanity - recognize different ways of experiencing autonomy and of understanding its demands and impact on individuals and groups.
