SUBJECT: Musical Theatre LEVEL: Secondary Five Optional Course

Reasons for this course:

- To promote different dance, music and acting within a Drama context.
- To introduce ideas, theories, practices, and the basic theatre terminology
- To help students have a better understanding of theatre's impact on society and society's impact on film.
- The course will promote leadership, English language arts and performing arts by providing supplemental knowledge in the understanding of theatre's role in society.

Program Outline:

- This course will be offered to students in Cycle II, Year III and will follow the recommended course of study as outlined in the QEP (Arts Drama option).
- Musical Theatre will define basic terms, explain how it differs from other media, it will give students the opportunity to analyze different theatrical pieces and create their own theatrical piece.
