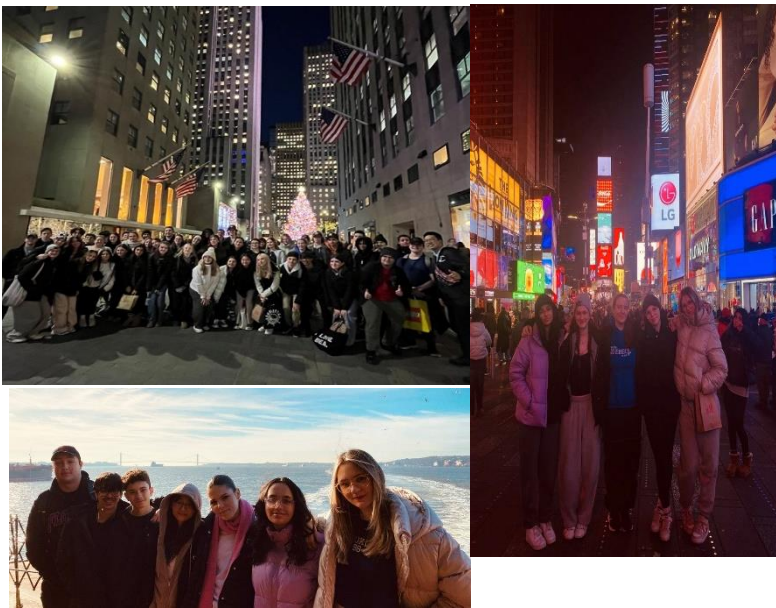
Senior Play 2023: A Wedding and a Funeral
