Subject: World Geography – Senior Option Course Level: Cycle 2, Year 3 (Sec. 5)

Course Description and Objectives

In this course we will study the different regions of the world including North America, South America, Europe, the Middle East, Asia, Africa, and Australia. For each region of the world, the class will examine the physical environment, the culture and people, the economic activities of the regions and current events associated with these areas.

The student objectives are:

- To demonstrate a basic knowledge of location, landforms, and resources of geographic regions.
- To develop skills in the use of maps, globes, and other graphic tools to acquire and process geographic information.
- To understand how geography has affected the economic, social, and cultural development of cultural regions.
- To analyze issues that challenge people from various regions of the world.

Subject Specific Competencies

Competency 1: To make sense of a territorial issue

Competency 2: To construct his/her global consciousness

Evaluation:

Evaluation will be based on assignments, projects, group work, quizzes, and end of term evaluation situations. Evaluation of both competencies will occur regularly, and throughout each of the three terms. The student will receive one mark that reflects their ability to master the course competencies.
