Subject: Film Creation

Level: Secondary 5

Course Description:

• To promote different types of media within a Drama context.

• To introduce ideas, theories, practices, and the basic terminology of film in the classroom to help students have a better understanding of film's impact on society and society's impact on film.

• The course will promote leadership, English language arts and performing arts by providing supplemental knowledge in the understanding of the film's role in society.

Program Outline:

• This course will be offered to students in Cycle II, Year II and will follow the recommended course of study as outlined in the QEP (Arts Drama option).

• Film appreciation will define basic terms, explain how it differs from other media, it will give students the opportunity to analyze film and create their own short films.
