Subject: Leadership **Level**: Secondary 5 – Option Course

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this course will be to provide students with a platform to develop essential leadership skills and to foster individuals who possess the tools to face current and future challenges in our global society. Over the course of the year, students will be given various opportunities to refine their leadership skills through participation in a series of activities within our school as well as the community. Through discussion and written assignments, students will then reflect on their approach to leadership with the aim of raising awareness of their own leadership potential.
