GRADE 6 MATH BOOST CAMP



(60 hours)

2 week Math Boost Camp from July 4 – July 15, 2016 (9am – 4pm)

The camp is intended for students who are experiencing difficulties in mathematics. Students **must** have a minimum final mark of **50%**. A referral from one's elementary school principal is a prerequisite.

Students who register for this course will participate in 30 hours of mathematics to prepare them for grade 7. The focus will be on improving basic skills and competency through hands-on activities with experienced math teachers. In addition, students will take part in 30 hours of multi-sport recreational activities.

REGISTRATION: Registration form and payment must be sent to R.S.B. by **May 20, 2016**

COST: \$325.00 per course for students who attended R.S.B. schools
\$425.00 for outside candidates (if space available)
Supplementary fees may apply should Daycare services be needed

GRADE 6 FRENCH BOOST CAMP



(60 hours)

2 week Math Boost Camp from July 4 – July 15, 2016 (9am – 4pm)

The camp is intended for students who are experiencing difficulties in French. Students **must** have a minimum final mark of **50%**. A referral from one's elementary school principal is a prerequisite.

Students who register for this camp will participate in a ten-day intensive camp (30 hours) to practice French in various situations such as role playing, discussions and games.

Students will have the opportunity to practice and build confidence in French Second Language comprehension and oral communication needed for daily life. In addition, students will take part in 30 hours of multi-sport or art recreational activities in the afternoon.

COST: \$325.00 per course for students who attended R.S.B. schools
\$425.00 for outside candidates (if space available)
Supplementary fees may apply should Daycare services be needed

SECONDARY REMEDIAL SESSIONS – SECONDARY I, II & SECONDARY III (45 hours)

3 week course from **July 11 – July 29, 2016**

(8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. or 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m – determined by summer school)

SPECIAL 5 WEEK COURSE – MATHEMATICS 306 (100 hours)

5 week course from **June 27 – July 29, 2016** (8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.)

This five week (100 hours) course is specifically designed for students who require Secondary III math in order to be promoted to Secondary IV math. Successful completion of Math 206 or failure of Math 306, along with a recommendation / referral from one's school administrator is a prerequisite.

REGISTRATION: Registration form and payment must be sent to R.S.B. by **June 17, 2016**

COST: \$500.00 for students who attend R.S.B. school

CULTURE, SOCIAL & TECHNICAL MATHEMATICS 414 (125 hours)

4 week course from **June 27 – July 22, 2016** (8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.)

This four week (125 hours) course is specifically designed for students who require Secondary IV math in order to obtain their High School Diploma, or be promoted to Secondary V mathematics. Successful completion of Math 306 is a prerequisite.

REGISTRATION: Registration form and payment must be sent to R.S.B. by **June 17, 2016**

COST: \$500.00 for students who attend R.S.B. schools

SPECIAL 3 WEEK SCIENCE OF THE ENVIRONMENT 402

3 week course from July 4 – July 22, 2016 (Time to be confirmed)

This three week course is designed for students who have successfully completed Science & Technology 444/Applied Science & Technology 416 and wish to bridge into Chemistry 404 and/or Physics 404. This course is also geared to students who need Science of the Environment 402 as a prerequisite for entry into CEGEP programs.

COST: \$480.00 for students who attend R.S.B. schools

SPECIAL 4 WEEK SCIENTIFIC MATH 426 COURSE

(80 hours)

4 week course from **June 27 – July 22, 2016** (8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.)

This four week (80 hours) course is designed for students who have successfully completed Cultural, Social and Technical Mathematics 414 and wish to bridge into Scientific and Technical Mathematics 506. This course is geared to students who need Scientific and Technical Mathematics 426 or Scientific Mathematics 426 as a prerequisite for entry into certain CEGEP programs.

Students **must** be recommended by their school administration.
