GRADE 6 MATH BOOST CAMP



(60 hours)

2 week Math Boost Camp from July 9 – July 20, 2018 (9am – 4pm)

The camp is intended for students who are experiencing difficulties in mathematics. Students **must** have a minimum final mark of **50%**. A referral from one's elementary school principal is a prerequisite.

Students who register for this course will participate in 30 hours of mathematics to prepare them for grade 7. The focus will be on improving basic skills and competency through hands-on activities with experienced math teachers. In addition, students will take part in 30 hours of multi-sport recreational activities.

REGISTRATION: Registration form and payment must be sent to R.S.B. by **May 25, 2018**

COST: \$325.00 per course for students who attended R.S.B. schools
\$425.00 for outside candidates (if space available)
Supplementary fees may apply should Daycare services be needed

SECONDARY REMEDIAL SESSIONS – SECONDARY I, II & SECONDARY III

(45 hours)

3 week course from July 16 – August 3, 2018

(8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. or 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. – determined by summer school)

PRE-CALCULUS COURSE



Preparation for CEGEP Calculus from **July 9 – July 20, 2018** (Time to Be Determined)

The objective of this course is to assist students with the basic mathematics skills and requirements for Calculus I offered in mathematics, business and science programs at the CEGEP level. Students are to have successfully completed SN Math 506 or TS Math 506 to register for this course.

COST: \$400.00 per course for students who attended R.S.B. schools

SPECIAL 3 WEEK SCIENCE OF THE ENVIRONMENT 402

3 week course from July 9 – July 27, 2018 (Afternoon Course - Time to be confirmed)

This three week course is designed for students who have successfully completed Science & Technology 444/Applied Science & Technology 416 and wish to bridge into Chemistry 404 and/or Physics 404. This course is also geared to students who need Science of the Environment 402 as a prerequisite for entry into CEGEP programs.

COST: \$350.00 for students who attend R.S.B. schools

SPECIAL 4 WEEK SCIENTIFIC MATH 426 COURSE

4 week course from **July 3 – July 27, 2018** (8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.)

This four week course is designed for students who have successfully completed Cultural, Social and Technical Mathematics 414 and wish to bridge into Scientific and Technical Mathematics 506. This course is geared to students who need Scientific and Technical Mathematics 426 or Scientific Mathematics 426 as a prerequisite for entry into certain CEGEP programs.

Students **must** be recommended by their school administration.

COST: \$500.00 for students who attend R.S.B. schools

Students may contact Summer School starting July 6, 2018 to confirm their secondary IV and V results. We encourage students to make sure they confirm their results to ensure that registration to courses and/or examination rewrites is done in time for summer programming.
